Performance Management for Immediately Reportable and 24 Hour Reportable Communicable Disease:

- Immediately reportable diseases are responded to and investigated immediately 100% of the time.
- 24 hour reportable diseases are responded to and investigated on the same day, or on the next day 100% of the time.

***Included in this report is Manalapan (a Consortium town) along with MCRHC towns and Middletown.**

***There has been a significant overall increase in Novel Coronavirus 2019 cases in the last 6 months (for all towns). There has been a decrease in both reported and Confirmed cases of Coronavirus (COVID-19) for the month of August (2020).**
