**Performance Management for Immediately Reportable and 24 Hour Reportable Communicable Disease:**

- Immediately reportable diseases are responded to and investigated immediately 100% of the time.
- 24 hour reportable diseases are responded to and investigated on the same day, or on the next day 100% of the time.

**There has been a significant increase in Novel Coronavirus 2019 cases in the last 4 months (for all towns), although there has been a notable decrease in cases for June of 2020.**
